based on the original "Switch" décor from Villeroy & Boch. What a great heritage!

V Joints for an Authentic Look

With the exception of the travertine decors of the Heritage collection, all panels of the

Villeroy & Boch Flooring Line feature a bevelled V-shaped groove running around all

four sides. The edges themselves are flat, so that the flush-installed panels have the

appearance of wooden boards. The colour of the joints has been chosen to blend

harmoniously with each décor.

**Fast, Easy Installation** 

The Swiss Krono Group equips the panels of the Villeroy & Boch Flooring Line with

the patented CLIC system, which makes installing them extremely quick and easy.

There's no need for any tools or glue, and the floor can be walked on right away.

It's also no problem to lay the laminate floors of the Villeroy & Boch Flooring Line on

top of underfloor heating, provided that the relevant special instructions are followed

(see <u>www.floors.villeroy-boch.com</u>). The panels' properties, which include a favourable

heat transfer coefficient (u-value), natural foot warmth and a uniform surface

temperature, even help to cut down on heating costs.

Matching skirting boards are available for all decors.
